At 1740H a Aero Scout chopper fr 123d Avn Co was downed by enemy fire at BS762358. Three of the crew members were injured badly. Co A 3d plat moved into the area of the downed chopper and secured it. At 1845H 1st plat of Co D spotted 10 VC in the open at BS830311. Arty fire was cont
