

| SUMMARY: At 0815 Recon/3-187 CA'd into 911565 and became OPCON to 4-3. At 0850 Recon/3-187 observed 3 NVA setting up booby traps and called in ARA and arty resulting in 3 NVA KIA. At 0955 at 911565 Recon/3-187 observed 4 more NVA and employed ARA with unknown results. At 1030 at 927547 Bn CP took Enemy mortar rounds resulting in 1 US KIA. At 1130 1/A Co moved to recover US bodies at 925549 and were engaged with SAF and command detonated claymores resulting in 6 US WIA (minor) and 2 NVA KIA. The bodies were recovered. At 1315 A Co was extracted to CaLu to become OPCON to 1-77 Arm and C/3-187 were inserted into 927547 and became OPCON to 4-3 Inf. | | | | | | | | |
