During the period 06 Apr to 12 Apr 68 the 4th Bn 3d Inf continued operations throughout the 4th Bn 3d Inf AO. On 9 Apr 4th Bn 3d Inf CP became operational from LZ DOTTIE, vic BS 629854. TFB disbanded 09 Apr 68 at 1200 hrs. The entire MUSCATINE AO is the responsibility of the 4th Bn 3d Inf.

1. Co A conducted stand-down and LZ SUE security for the period 06 Apr to 12 Apr. One platoon, effective 08 Apr, conducted extensive ambushes and day patrols along the Tra Bong river/valley area.

#### SIGNIFICANT EVENTS:

a. 072230 Apr 68, received 22 rounds of 60mm mortar fire. Counter-mortar fired by 4.2" mortar platoon. Enemy fire ceased 2245 hours w/negative damage or friendly casualties.

2. Co B was released OPCON of TF BARKER at 091200H Apr 68. Co B remained on LZ DOTTIE and LZ UPTIGHT as security.

#### SIGNIFICANT EVENTS:

a. 092115H Apr 1st platoon sprung an ambush resulting in 3 VC KIA vic BS 620834.

b. 102150 Apr vic BS639842 2d plat sprung an ambush resulting in 2 VC KIA.

c. 112030 Apr vic BS637854 1st plat sprung an ambush resulting in VC returning fire with automatic and semi-automatic weapons. Ambush returned to LZ DOTTIE and 4.2" mortar platoon fired on ambush site with unknown results.

3. Co C conducted operations in the Tra Bong River/Valley area in support of Operation GOLDEN FLEECE 06 Apr to 08 Apr. On 08 Apr Co C 4-3 Inf became OPCON to 1-20 Inf in support of Operation NORFOLK VICTORY until 11 Apr when Co C was C/A back to control of 4-3 Inf vic BS521724 at 1203 hrs.

#### SIGNIFICANT EVENTS:

a. 111923 hrs Apr vic BS538738 1st platoon sprung ambush resulting in 1 VC KIA & 1 M-1 rifle captured.

b. 120400H Apr vic BS538738 1st plat ambush sprung resulting in 1 US slightly wounded. Individual threw hand grenade at enemy and grenade failed to detonate. When individual stuck his head up to engage enemy with small arms the grenade detonated, slightly wounding individual in head. Individual
