In the Americal AO there were 14 enemy initiated incidents resulting in 13 US WHA while the enemy suffered 17 KIA.

The Norfolk Victory AO is no longer in existence effective upon the airlift of the 1-20 Inf to the OPCON of the 196th LIB.

The 4-21 Inf closed in its' entirety to the Duc Pho AO. Co's A & D are on LZ Bronco. Co's C & E and the Bn CP are on LZ Thunder. Co B is located on LZ Charlie Brown. All companies of 4-21 Inf will continue to receive classes on combat essentials.
