Due to a decrease in Local Force and Main Force unit activities, local guerrillas will increase sapper activities.

There is an unidentified NVA regt moving into the Quang Ngai and Quang Tri Provinces.

Rocket site used to rocket Chu Lai, 22 Apr, were found 10K W of Chu Lai by 5-46 Inf, 198 LIB.
