During the period 30 Mar to 5 Apr the 4th Bn 3d Inf continued normal operations throughout the 4th Bn 3d Inf AO with one combat assault on 1 Apr 68.

1. Co A conducted extensive night ambushes and day patrols along the Tra Bong River/valley area and conducted a CA to the SE from BS5982, E to BS6382, S to BS6379, W to BS5979 and N to BS5982.

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS:

- a. On 1 Apr 68 Co A wade a CA into three separate IZs in support of three FF platoons and one National Police platoon from Son Tinh District. Light contact was established resulting in 3 VC KIA, 4 VC CIA and 4 individual weapons captured.
- b. On 3 Apr 68 2d Plat of Co A conducted security operations for a road recon team of the 26th Engr. The 2d Plat encountered two booby traps resulting in 2 US KHA and 13 US WHA six of the 13 were evacuated for wounds. The others were minor and remained in the field.

 - e. On 5 Apr 68 Co A moved to 12 Sue for a stand down.
 - 2. Co B OPCON to TF BARKER.
- 3. Co C continued to provide security for IZ Sue from 30 Mar to 5 Apr. On 5 Apr Co C moved to continue GOLDEN FLEECE operations along the Tra Bong river/valley replacing Co A.
- 4. Co D continued operations in the central and southwestern areas of the 40 with extensive night ambushes and day patrols around the company base camp.
- 5. Recon Plat continued security of OP George with extensive ambushes to day patrols around the surrounding areas of OP George.
