37	LOG Summary: (U) 4-3 Inf continues offensive search and amb ops in the SAN JUAN HILL FCA with Co D securing LZ SAN JUAN HILL, Co C commencing a Stand Down at Chu Lai at 0850H and Co's A, B & Ron plat operating in grid squares 6142, 6243 and 6344. At 0905H Co A 1st plat at coord BS619421 fd a lge food cache that was buried in the ground (see entry #11). The cache was later airlifted fr its loc to LZ SAN JUAN HILL at 1525H. At 1315H Co B had 1 US EM rec a bullet wound fr an exploding rd caused by a fire that started in Co B's NDP. All of Co B's elms were forced to leave the NDP site leaving equipment and ammunition behind. The wounded man was Dusted Off by the C&C ship at 1320H. There were several items that had to be left when Co B departed the burning site but later at 1910H all items rept'd missing were found. At 0940H all of Co D's elms had completed an air move fr Stand Down to assume responsibility for the
