Co C 4-21 Inf had one individual wander off by himself during a search of an area near the coast. Once this individual was discovered missing an intensified search was conducted to try to locate this individual, but to no avail. At 2300 hrs at an RD area in the South part of the Duc Pho AO his body, wrapped in white sheets, was delivered to the RD camp. On his body were two notes of propaganda. The notes in essence stated that the VC did not want to fight this war and how much of a group of good guys they were for bringing back the body.

VC cadre are dressing up in monks clothing to evade U.S. troops.

S-3:

5 enemy initiated incidents in the Americal AO.

Can Duc SF Camp was evacuated. Estimate 300 NVA KIA in that area. 7 US KIA, 66 US WFA, 20 US MFA. Also destroyed were 2 C-130s, 2 CH-47s, 2 gunships, and 1 Medevac ship.
