At 0825H D Co engaged 3 NVA/VC with s/a fire, the NVA/VC envaded to the EA, 1 US rec'd frag wds in the left arm fr an M-79, then C&C dusted him off to Duc Pho. At 0905 A Co engaged 1 NVA with s/a fire neg res. At 1100 D Co engaged 3 NVA with s/a fire, res 2 NVA KIA, 1 NVA WIA, the NVA were wearing green fatigues, 1 NVA pack, 1 NVA pistol belt, neg wps. At 1120 A Co found a Nva basecamp with 2 rucksacks, 2 bloodtrails and an assortment of clothes and equipment. Their were neg other significant events throughout the day.
