2. 4-3 Inf conducts offensive search and ambush operations in assigned FGA to find and destroy NVA main/local force units, interdict enemy base camps and locations and eliminate village VC infrastructure.

3. Co A:

- b. Conduct offensive sweep to the Northwest via Hill 416, continue offensive sweep to Southwest.
- c. At completion of sweep, conduct search and ambush operations in assigned FGA.

- b. Conduct offensive sweep South to Hills 16h, 2h6, and 416, continue sweep to the Northwest.

- a. 140615H June 69 depart LZ SAN JUAN, move to blocking positions, via BS613398, to BS622h12.
- b. Block enemy withdrawal from Hill 416 and 2h6.
- c. At completion of sweep conduct search and ambush operations in assigned FGA.

  - (2) Move to LZ SAN JUAN. PZ LZ DON.
  - (3) Deploy by foot to conduct ambush operations via BS618392.
- b. h.2 Mortar Plat: GS FSB SAN JUAN.
- c. GS Section: GS FSB SAN JUAN.

8. Coordinating Instructions:

- a. Direct coordination between units authorized and directed.
- b. Airlift and extraction controlled on Air/Ground frequency 48.60.
- c. All companies will carry 2 days supply of C Rations.
- d. Bn CP will be relocated to LZ SAN JUAN NLF 1100H.
- e. Warlords will block Northeast flank of operations area.
