

In Memory of Native American Indians who served and died in the Vietnam War

Native Americans have one of the highest record of service in the Vietnam War, per capita, of any ethnic group. A majority of these men enlisted, and a disproportional number served in combat positions: in infantry regiments, tank battalions, airborne and airmobile units, and artillery batteries.

During the Vietnam War, close to 90% of the 86,000 Indians who enlisted volunteered.

Native American Indians served in Vietnam from Aug 1964 to May 1975.

Over half served in combat. 300 were Killed in Action. KIA
